I Have a Pending Reservation For a Discussion Group. Does This Mean I Am Scheduled?

When qualifying for a discussion group there are two components

1. The Online Survey
2. The Follow-Up Phone Call

If you qualify through the online survey, you will then need to complete a follow-up phone call with one of our recruiters.

At the end of the online survey, you will be asked to choose a timeslot. For discussion groups, this choice simply reserves a spot for you at that time. Until you have spoken on the phone with one of our recruiters, you are not scheduled.

Once the follow-up phone call is completed, the recruiter will confirm that you are fully qualified and will schedule you OR the recruiter will tell you that you do not meet the full requirements and will cancel your reservation. You can view your Pending Reservations under My Account at www.fpitesters.com.

We may cancel your reservation if a quota fills before we are able to get back to you. If this happens we will release your reservation and you will be free to qualify for other tests.

Discussion Group Attendance Policy

Discussion groups are fun, and they pay more than taste tests. We recruit a very small number of testers to participate so it is extremely important to attend as scheduled.

If you need to cancel, call ahead to let us know so we will be able to consider you for future discussion groups.
